 - a. Allocate funding for ECE changed
 - b. Whole Child Money – it was recommendation for 1.0 FTE Psychologist but didn't allocate for the resources and FTE ~\$40,000 – this money will come out of the SEAL grant next year
 - c. Work of Wellness Center will help with rolling out the SEAL curriculum next year!
 - d. This year we were able to fund the same teachers and staff as the previous school year, but not add any next year (will try to find money for more paras in the fall)
 - e. Expecting to have some carry over next year

- This year, the interventions in Wellness Center currently using Random Act of Kindness curriculum
- Idea to add nutrition to the Wellness Center (correlation between nutrition and behavior) – host workshop for parents for nutrition
